Dear Tremonton City Water Customer:

You are receiving this letter because over the past year you have either moved into a newly built home or you have had your existing water meter replaced. All new culinary water meters owned and placed by Tremonton City Water Utility Department are what's classified as AMI Fixed Network meters, which means that twice a day, around 12:00 noon and 12:00 midnight the meters broadcast the water usage for that meter to a base station receiver which then stores the water use data in a cloud-based storage site. As a customer with the AMI meters, you can set up a web-based account and down load an App. to a device which will allow you to view and manage your water use more closely.

The software through the app will allow you to customize your water usage, set alarms for high use or continual use, thus helping to notify you of a possible water leak. Typical water use is around 50-75 gallons per day per individual in a residence, newer homes with newer appliances will generally be lower in water use due to newer requirements for conservation in the design of appliances.




