Explorers will get the chance to serve their community and learn the proper use of equipment and tools, ladder techniques, wildland firefighting procedures, and more.

As an Explorer, you must attend all the meetings and trainings. After completing the required safety training, you will be encouraged to sign up for a ride-along. Other community events and activities will be announced throughout the year.
