- NO YARD WASTE OR GRASS
- NO GLASS
- NO SHREDDED PAPER
- NO CLOTHES, SHOES
- NO TOYS OR OVERSIZED PLASTIC ITEMS
- NO NEEDLES OR MEDICAL WASTE
- NO STYROFOAM
- NO WAXY OR GLOSSY PAPER ITEMS
- NO BATTERIES
- NO CONTAINERS WITH LIQUID
- NO DIAPERS
- NO PLASTIC LINED MAIL POUCHES

A FEW REMINDERS:

- Please place containers at least 6 feet from other containers or objects
- Please DO NOT block containers with vehicles
- Please DO NOT over load your container. If the lid is open more than 2 inches, it is considered to be overloaded. Please contact the City's Public Works Dept. if you need an additional container
- Cardboard boxes MUST be broken down, and/or cut into small pieces. Please do not lay flattened boxes on top of container
- Please only place acceptable recyclable items into your recycling container (see list)
